Find of the month Rules

COIN: A coin is a coin. It may be from another country, however it must have been made for monetary or commemorative purpose and must be legal tender.

JEWELLERY: If you would wear it as a piece of jewellery then it goes in the jewellery category, it's as simple as that. This would include rings, necklaces, earrings, bracelets, brooches, tie pins, religious pendants, etc. Whether they are costume jewellery pieces or made from precious metals.

MISCELLANEOUS: This category is the catch all for everything else. This also included watches and pocket watches. If in doubt about the category of an item or have any questions, speak to a member prior to submitting your item.

RULES: You must be a paid up member to enter a find.

Item must have been found since previous meeting.

Only one item per category may be entered.

Enter by placing your item on numbered square and fill in description (not your name) on the category listing sheet. Write your name on sheet at end of meeting after vote has taken place.

POINTS AND PRIZES:

Ist place in category:	4 points - Wins a silver half dollar.
2nd place in category:	3 points - Wins a silver quarter.
3rd place in category:	2 points - Wins a silver dime.
Loser Draw:	0 points - Wins silver quarter.
Enter an item:	1 point - No prize.
