### The Loonie Lotto

Contest: Every monthly meeting, members who have found Loonies during that month (from the last meeting to the current meeting) choose one of them to enter the contest and that Loonie will go in a pot. One token representing each year a Loonie was minted is put into a jar and one is drawn. The member who has the Loonie of the same year as the Token wins the Pot.

### Rules:

- The Loonie entered must have been found while metal detecting.
- Only a Loonie found after the previous monthly meeting can be entered.
- Only one Loonie can be entered per game. So if you found several...choose one but the others cannot be entered at the following monthly meeting.
- Each Member places his or her Loonie on the table where the Hunt Master can see it.
- Hunt Master draws one Token from the Token Jar
- The Member with the corresponding year wins all the entered Loonies.
- If more than one winner, the Pot is divided accordingly.
- If no one has the winning Loonie, all Loonies go into the Pot and the Pot is carried to the next Monthly Meeting.
- The Token that was drawn is retired from future draws. So pay attention not to enter a year already called. Check the monthly newsletter!
- A Member who joins the game after having missed one or more meetings must equalize their entries into the game by contributing as many Loonies as meetings missed. Tip #1: If you find more than one Loonie during the month, remember that the mintage of loonies varies widely from year to year. If you can, it would be a smart play to enter a year with the lowest mintage. Then hope that most of the other players enter a loonie from one of the higher mintage years. When your year is drawn, you may not have to split the pot.

Loonie Draw - 2018, 2014, 2007, 2004, 1987 and 1996 are now retired.

## **May Club Hunt**

### Sunday May 26 @ 10:30 AM, Mineola Ghost Town, Summerland

We'll meet at Mineola at 10:30am. Park in the clearing just west of the road.

### What to bring:

Bring your detector(s) and if you have a selection of coils, bring a mid size and a small size. There are large open areas, but also a lot of metal junk so a small coil might make a good find around the trash. Bring a lawn chair, bug spray, good boots as there is lots of glass and metal. Bring your own lunch and drinks including water.

### How to get there:

Start from the traffic circle at the corner of Victoria Road and Prairie Valley Road in Summerland. Follow Prairie Valley Road west to Doherty Ave where you turn right. After a short distance the main road will turn to the left on Bathville Road then up a hill and turn right again on Princeton-Summerland Road. Continue until you get to Fish Lake Road (Falder Corner). At this point you will have travelled 25km. From Victoria Road turn right (north) on Fish Lake Road and drive 3km to Mineola. It is located at the second cattle guard. We will be parked on the west side of the road. The entire trip is on a paved surface.

### What we might find:

Mineola was built as a lumber camp to service the KVR but when the railroad was finished in the 1920's the town was abandoned. Some nice old coins have been found over the years and old tools and bottles are regularly found.

Chinese lived and worked in the town and there is a Chinese cemetery.
